All racing or wagering equipment or services licenses shall expire on December 31 of the expiration year. Prior to the expiration of a racing or wagering equipment or services license, the licensee may apply to the Kansas Racing and Gaming Commission (commission) for renewal of such license on a commission-approved application form and pay the required fees. Each licensee or applicant for a license shall report immediately and in writing any change in license or application information to the commission.

NOTE: All racing or wagering equipment or services licensee records pertaining to Kansas racetrack facilities are subject to review. Records may be subject to an audit review by commission staff at any time.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: All persons working at a racetrack facility on behalf of a licensed racing or wagering equipment or services provider must obtain an occupation license from the commission before beginning work at the racetrack. Forms are available from the commission.
